High on the priority of the councils business relating to Ings is the decision on High Knott Barn, Ings. There was an application to make an amendment to the local occupancy condition to correspond with draft Housing Supplementary Planning. There was a lengthy decision on this application that was inconclusive, so please email the Clerk for a copy. For other applications please see the minutes posted on the Parish Council notice board.

Parish council allotments are available in Staveley. The Parish Council owns two areas, one at Fell Foot and the other in Staveley village. If you are interested again contact the Clerk.

The New Abbey development is still ongoing. We have a great model which would include independent living apartments, alongside a care hub to support people if required in their own homes.

The Council is waiting for a consultation on highways improvements from County Council this spring. Proposals include parking restrictions in Staveley and 20 mph limits in Staveley and Ings. The request for a council dustbin at the bus stop in Ings is being processed and should be approved any time.
