#### STAVELEY WITH INGS PARISH COUNCIL - LATEST NEWS

The Staveley with Ings Parish Council meeting was held in the Staveley Pavilion on September 1<sup>st</sup> 2025. During this public participation part of the meeting, discussions were had regarding planning requests, United Utilities, placement of the S.I.D. to monitor the traffic speed and the right of way of the footpath behind the abbey. For a full copy of the minutes of the meeting please see the parish council website.

Regarding the request of the Parish Council to reduce the speed limit from 40 to 20 mph on several roads in Ings we have now had approval, as 57% of the residents who replied to the consultation supported the proposal. The next stage is to gain approval from Westmorland and Furness Council to progress to statutory consultation and advertisement of the Traffic Regulation Order.

Staveley or Ings residents with any issues are invited to come to the next Parish Council meetings that will be held on Monday 6th October at 7.15 in the Pavilion where they are given the chance in the public participation section to give their views and question the parish council on issues on the agenda or raise issues related to the Parish for future discussion.

#### Project updates at Church and Hall

Solar panels on Church roof: After a recent meeting with the National Park Conservation Officer we have been invited to re-submit the planning application - based upon our petition outcome, community use of the building and a reduction in number of panels from 28 to 22. New panels are 20% more efficient so the output remains the same. Preparation of the new application is now under way.

**River Wall:** The structural repair work to the wall is estimated to cost in excess of £100,000. An application to the Environment Agency for permission to work in the river is under way, involving an ecological survey and builder's method statement. The earliest date for working in the river is now July 2026.
