Long time Ings resident, Cynthia Kelsall was 100 on 17th Nov. Ings Village Hall hosted a Birthday breakfast in her honour on the 22nd. Her association with Ings goes back 85 years when her father relocated his small munitions manufactory from Kent to Ings shortly after the Battle of Britain in WW2. She attended Kendal High School then London University and became a Biology teacher, returning to Ings on her retirement.

Thereupon, Cynthia volunteered at the Lakeland Horticultural Society at Holehird, sang in Staveley Choral Society and enjoyed art classes in Ings Village Hall. She was a member of Bateman Club for many years and regularly attended musical events in the village. Cynthia wasn't well enough to be present to celebrate with some 80 friends, neighbours, and colleagues from Holehird, and enjoy the display of photos, memorabilia, Cynthia's sketches and botanical illustrations.

The Staveley with Ings Parish Council meeting was held on the 3rd November in Ings. Staveley or Ings residents with any issues are invited to all Parish Council meetings where they are given the chance in the public participation section to give their views and question the parish council on issues on the agenda or raise issues relating to the Parish for future discussion. The next Parish Council meeting is on Mon 5 January at 7.15pm at the Ayland Pavilion.

At the meeting members of the public raised concerns about road safety on the A591 from Plumgarths roundabout through Ings. The council agreed to form a subgroup to develop a highways plan. The Group will investigate whether the speed limit on the A591 at Ings should be reduced, along with what measures could help with road safety. Residents assistance would be greatly appreciated.
